Outcome:

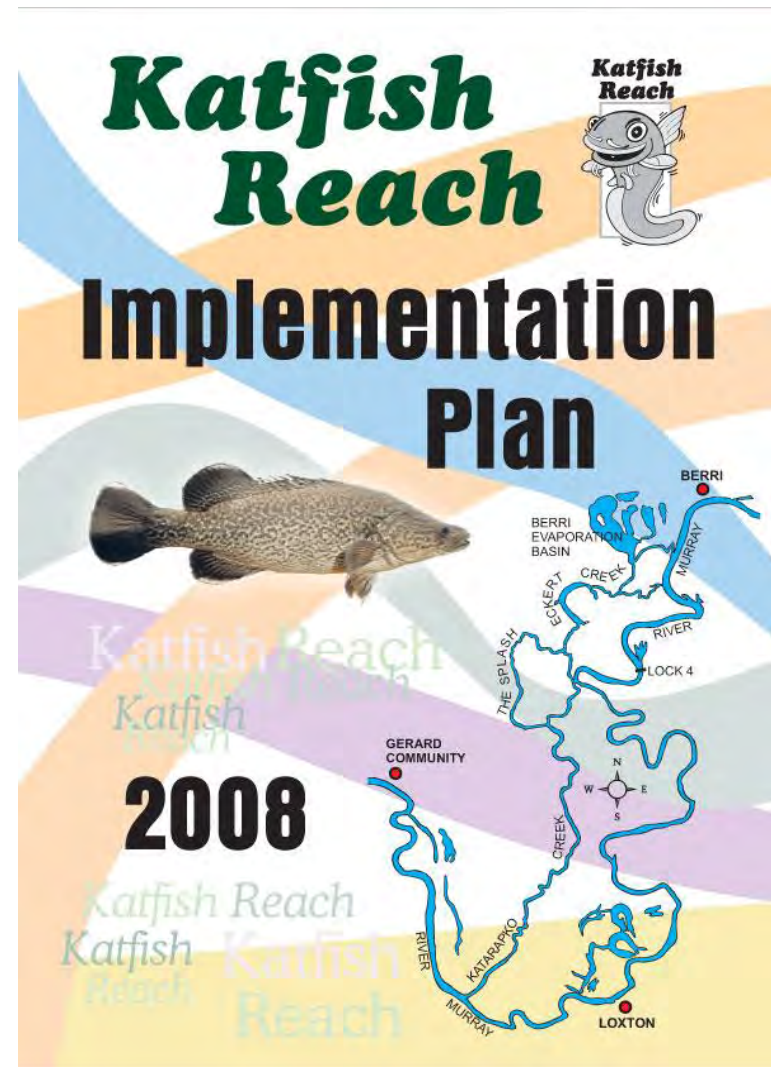
- Over 185 snags have been reintroduced

- Provide practical support (e.g. catering at Demo Reach Field Days)
